The development objective of the Espirito Santo Water Security Management Project for Brazil is to: (i) to strengthen the Borrower's capacity to manage water security risks in a changing climate; (ii) to reduce those risks in selected areas of the Borrower's territory; and (iii) in case of an eligible crisis or emergency, respond promptly and effectively to it. The project comprises of five components. The project will implement NBS to reduce water security risks in selected river basins and support integrated flood risk management.
